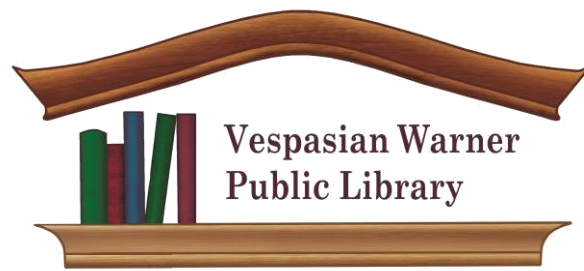

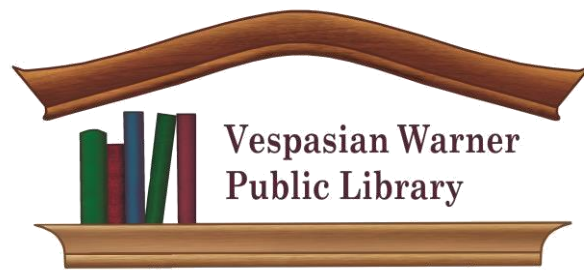

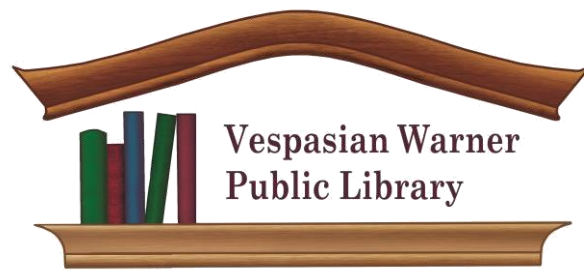

BIOGRAPHY

John W. Gaultney, 74, of Clinton died 12:45 a.m. Monday (Aug. 24, 2009) in Dr. John Warner Hospital, Clinton. Memorial services will be 11 a.m. Wednesday in Calvert Funeral Home, Clinton, with J. Kent Hickerson officiating. Visitation will be one hour before services. Burial will be in Pleasant Valley Cemetery, Kenney, with military rites. Memorials: First Christian Church Young At Heart, Clinton. John was born March 16, 1935, in Wapella, the son of John and Edna Dunn Gaultney. He was an Army veteran and member of First Christian Church. He enjoyed helping with the SHARE Foods at the DeWitt County Friendship Center. He retired from Bridgestone/Firestone Inc. after 34 years of service. He married Alice Marie Lobb on June 10, 1957, in Clinton. She preceded him in death on Dec. 31, 1991. He married Betty Morse Taylor on April 18, 1996, in Clinton. Surviving are his wife; children, Johnny Lynn Gaultney of Peotone; Scott David Gaultney of Weldon; David (Cheryle) Taylor of Waynesville; Marcia (John) Wise and Jim (Cindy) Taylor, all of Clinton; brothers and sisters, Dorine Smith of Clinton; Bob (Phyllis) Gaultney and Dick Gaultney, both of Kenney; 10 grandchildren; five great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents, first wife, two brothers and three sisters.
