BIOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION/ORGANIZATIONAL HISTORY

The John Warner Bank was founded in 1867 as John Warner & Co. It was reopened in 1911 as the John Warner Bank. In 2009, it was purchased by the State Bank of Lincoln.

The DeWitt Savings Bank was founded in 1887.

The First National Bank and Trust Company was founded in 1872 as the DeWitt County National Bank. It changed to the First National Bank and Trust Company in 1974. It was originally on the Square but moved to a new facility on Route 54 in 2005.
