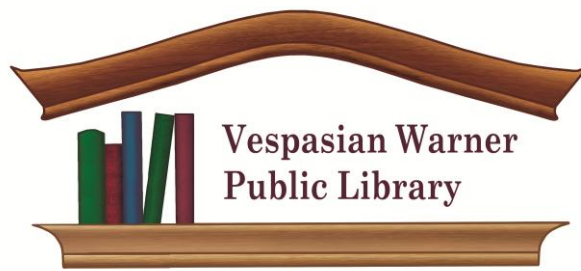

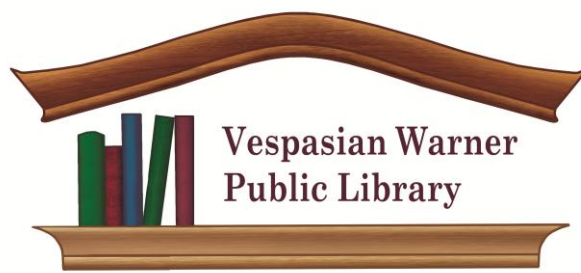

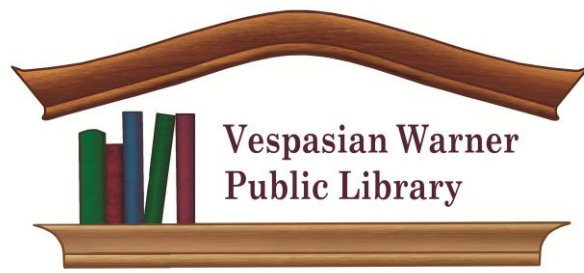
BIOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION/ORGANIZATIONAL HISTORY

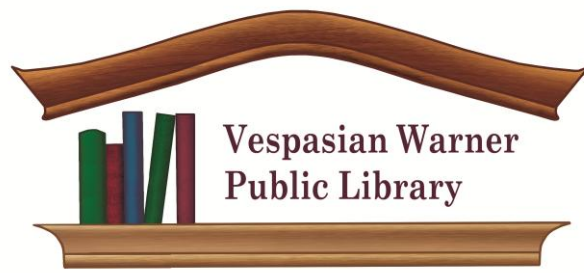
The Clinton Kiwanis Club was founded in 1922.

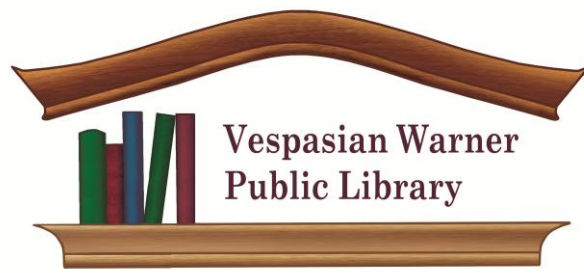
