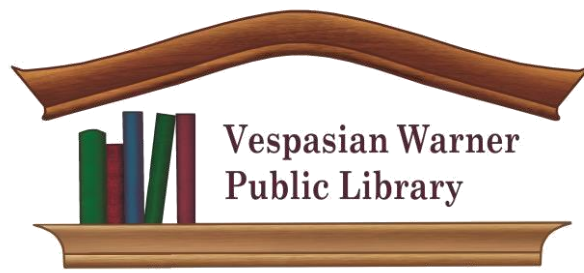

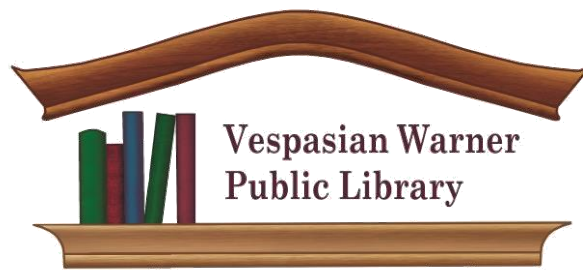

BIOGRAPHY

Errald Boyde Wilson, known as “Bobby”, was born December 3, 1919 in Elwin, Illinois. He later moved with his parents to 117 ½ S. Quincy St. in Clinton. He attended Clinton schools and graduated from Clinton Community High School in 1937. He studied dance under Jack Manning in New York. From 1937 to at least 1940, Wilson operated a dance school out of his parents’ home. His students had annual reviews at the Clintonia Theater and performed at various events in Clinton and surrounding communities.

Wilson served in the United States Army during World War II and was wounded twice. After the war, he and his wife, Mary, moved to St. Louis, where Wilson was employed by the Illinois Terminal Railroad and eventually served as its president.

Wilson retired to Port St. Lucie, Florida where he died February 22, 1994. He is buried in Memorial Park Cemetery in Clinton.
